

Bordered Square

8 “ Finished Block

Total Blocks Needed 35

Quilt Size 48 X 64

Yardage Requirements:

Blocks

- Blocks Center
 - From Fat Quarters – select 5 different colors
 - or
 - From Yardage – ½ yard based on 18” x 42” fabric size or ¾ yard based on 18” x 40” fabric size
- Block Sashing
 - 1 ¾ yard

Borders/Binding

- Border #1 (3 inch border) – 5/8 yard
- Border #2 (5 inch border) – 1 1/8 yard
- Binding – ½ yard

Backing – 5 yard

Batting – 56 x 72 allows for 4” on either side

Cutting Instructions for each block

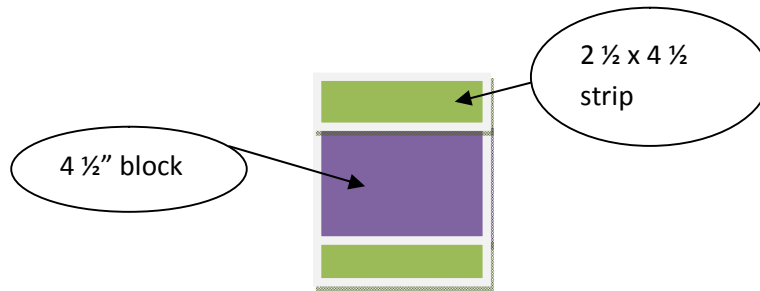
- **From Fat Quarters** - Cut (8) 4 ½ “ squares from each of 7 fat qtrs and (3) 4 ½” squares from remaining fat qtrs yielding 35 squares
- **From Yardage** - cut (4) strips 4 ½” wide, from each strip cut (35) 4 ½” squares
- **From Sashing** – based on 42” fabric cut 30 2 1/2 “ strips. Subcut into (70) 2 ½” x 4 ½” strips and (70) 2 ½” x 8 ½” strips

Cutting Instructions for borders and binding

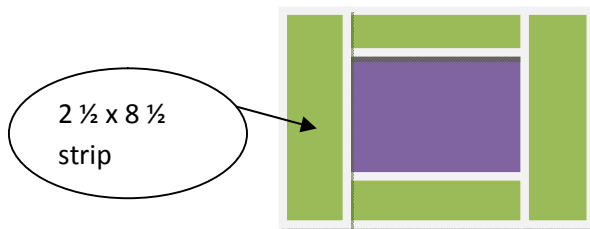
- **Border #1** – cut 6 strips 3 ½” wide
- **Border #2** – cut 7 strips 5 ½” wide
- **Binding** – cut 7 strips 2 ½” wide

Construction:

Step 1



Step 2



Step 3 – Sew 5 blocks across making one row. Make 7 rows of 5 blocks each. Sew the 7 rows together.

Step 4 – Add the 3 ½” border #1

Step 5 – Add the 5 ½” border #1

Step 6 – Sandwich, quilt and bind
